Year 6 have been busy completing activities about transition to High School as they will be finding out which High School they will be attending on Monday!

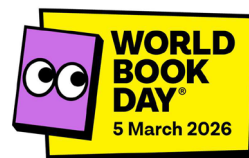
Well done to some of our Year 4 children who attended Sportshall Athletics.
