Some of our Year 5 GIFT Team have had a reflective day at St Mary's Church on the Lenten Retreat organised by St Joseph's.

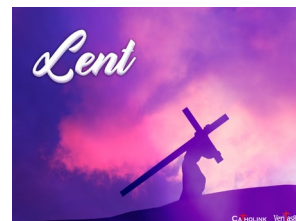
